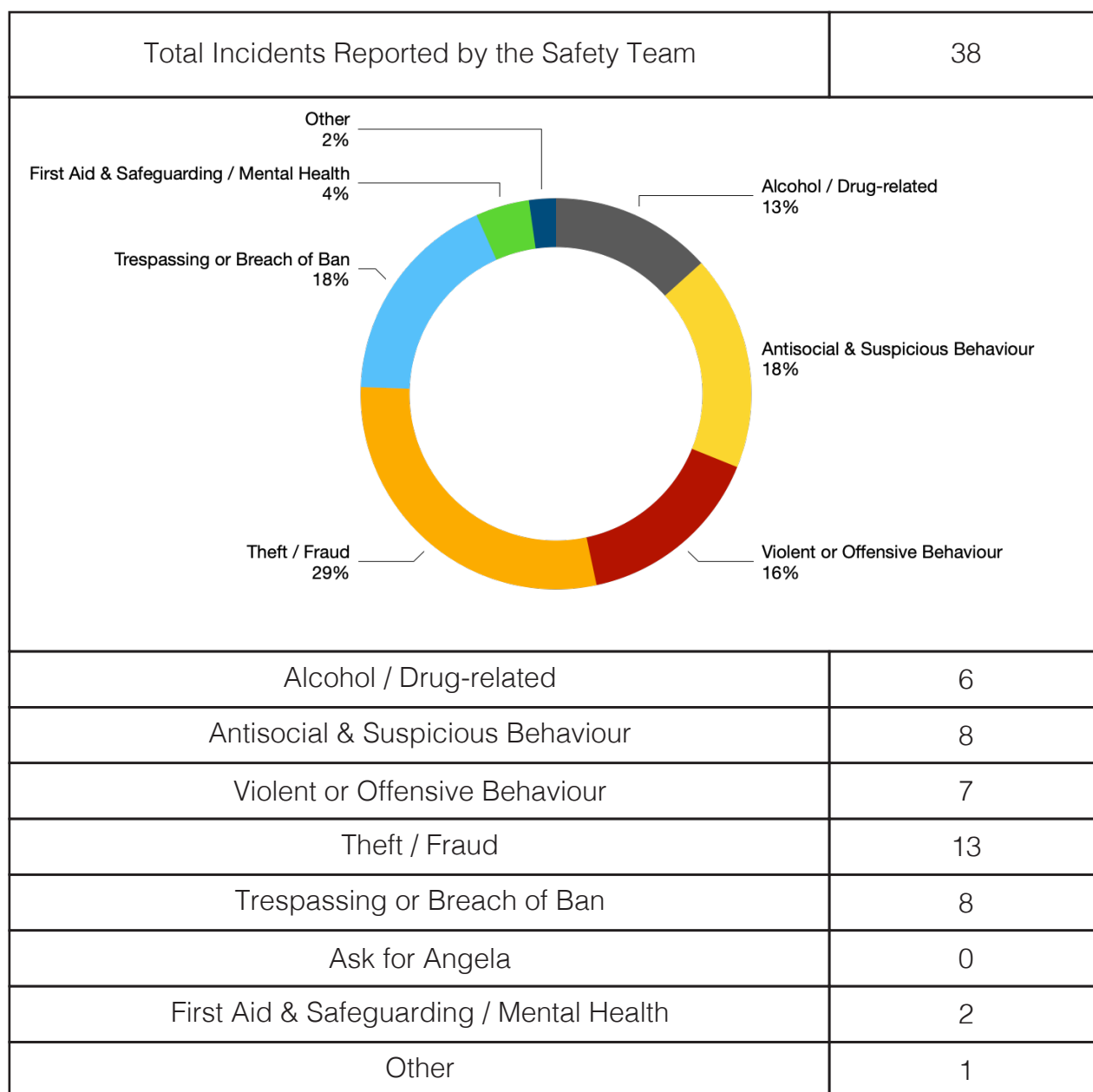


Your **August** Safety Team Summary

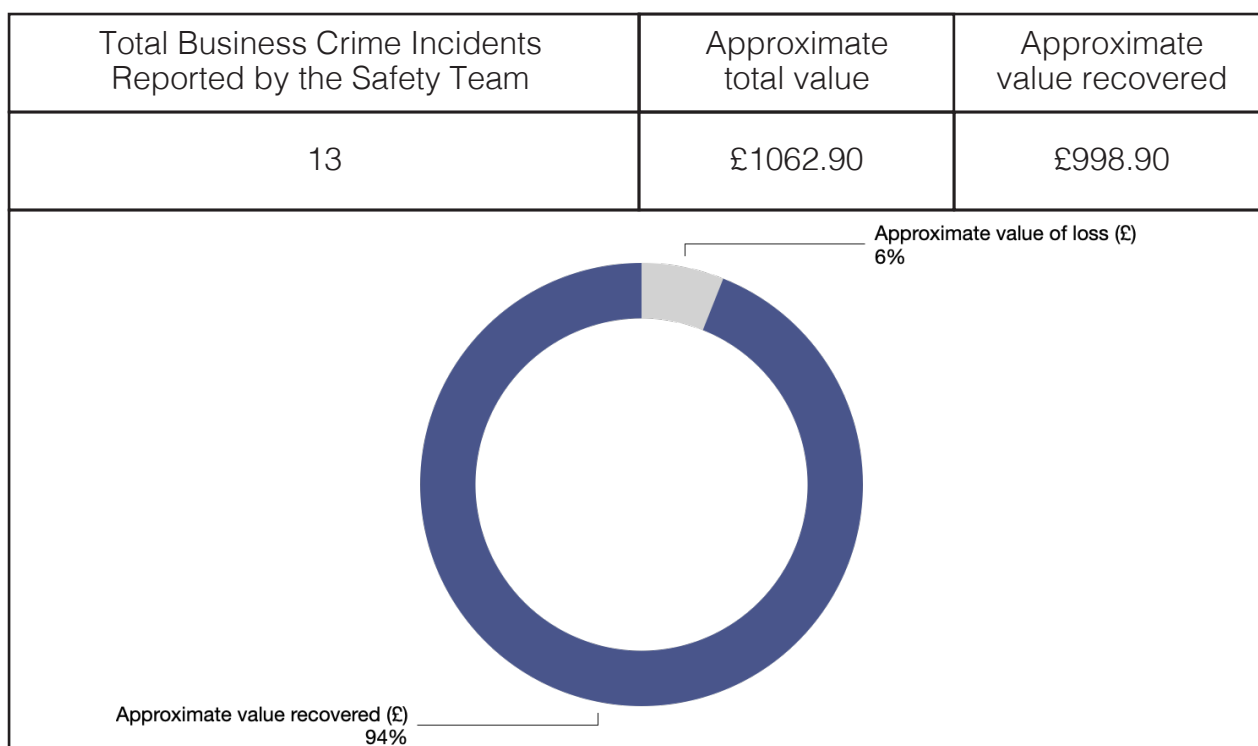

Incident Map



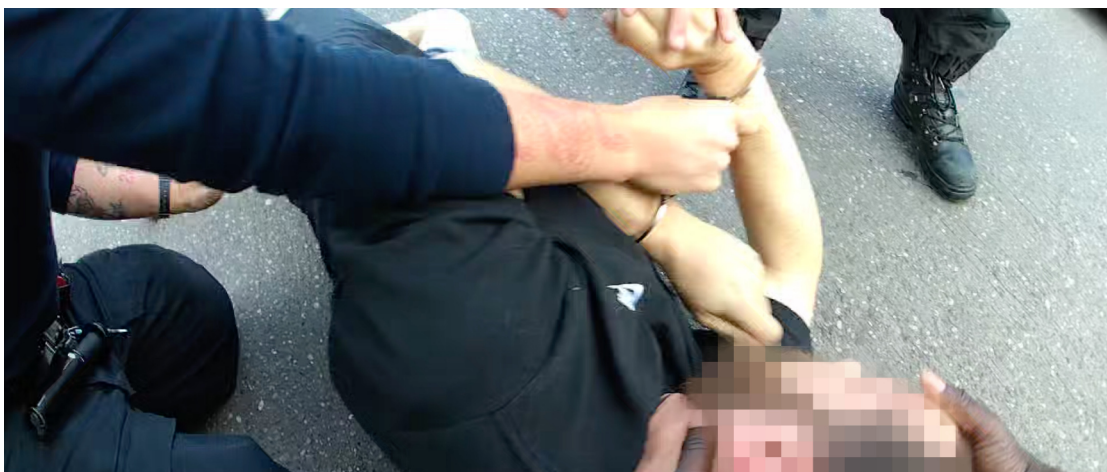
Monthly Highlights

Coordinated Response Leads to Arrest of Prolific Thieves

The Safety Team responded to a radio call from Sainsbury's security about a theft. The team learned that a known male and female duo, responsible for a string of thefts and attempted thefts worth approximately £4,000 from the store, had just stolen a trolley full of washing products.

The team's assistance led to the identification of the male as he was returning a trolley to the car park. After the male got into a taxi, the Safety Team made the proactive decision to stop the vehicle. The team discovered the stolen washing products in the taxi's boot which alerted passing police, who were finishing a separate deployment from a protest march.

As the couple exited the taxi and attempted to flee, the Safety Team successfully detained the male. Police officers pursued and caught the female. This decisive action not only stopped them from successfully committing the theft but also resulted in their arrest and identification for the previous thefts. Both individuals were taken to the police station. This incident highlights the team's professional judgement and effective partnership with both store security and the police, leading to the successful recovery of £544.00 worth of goods and the apprehension of two prolific offenders.



Volatile Situation Managed During Nuneaton Carnival

The Safety Team responded to a radio call from the Nuneaton Carnival's event security about a male shouting racial abuse at a family outside Iceland. Upon arrival, the team found the man in an irate state and quickly engaged him.

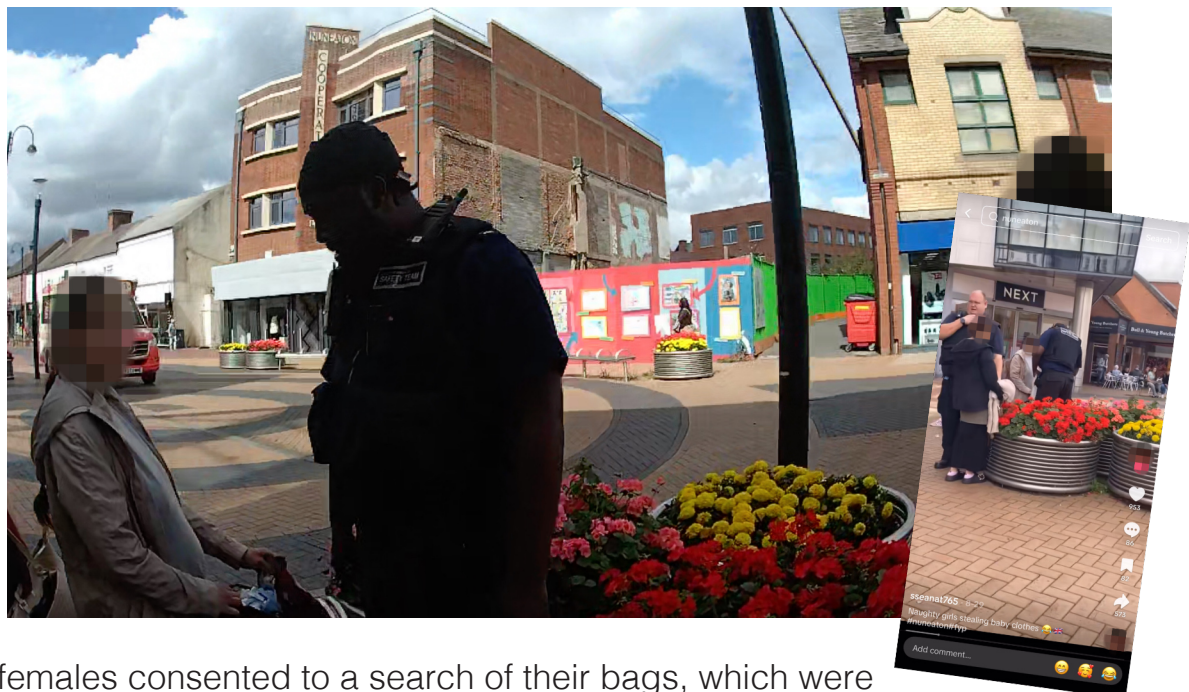
The team agreed to escort the male to the bus station on the condition that he remain calm and cease his abusive behaviour. While walking, the individual became increasingly aggressive, repeatedly shouting at passersby and turning on the team.



When the man attempted to trip a safety operative, a decision was made for everyone's safety to swiftly restrain and move the male away from the crowds. The police arrived shortly after and arrested him for his behaviour. This incident highlights the team's professional judgement and ability to de-escalate a rapidly deteriorating situation, culminating in a successful resolution with police intervention.

Swift Action Recovers Stolen Goods from Shoplifters

The team responded to a radio call from Poundland regarding two females who had filled backpacks with clothing and left the store. The team quickly located the individuals in the Ropewalk Shopping Centre and intercepted them.



The females consented to a search of their bags, which were found to be full of clothing from Poundland and makeup from Boots. The team escorted them back to Poundland, where the £182.00 of stolen goods were recovered and the females were detained while awaiting police arrival.

Despite the individuals becoming argumentative and attempting to leave, the team maintained control of the situation. After approximately 1 hour and 20 minutes, police arrived, took the females' details, and ensured they left the town via the train station. This incident highlights the team's swift response, resulting in the successful recovery of a significant amount of stolen goods. A video of the team stopping and searching the offenders gained traction on the social media platform TikTok, bringing wider attention to the team's effectiveness.

Impact and Outlook

August was a month of strategic wins and decisive action, reinforcing the Safety Team's vital role in the town. The Nuneaton Carnival provided a key test of our collaborative efforts. Working alongside the event's security team, the Safety Team played a crucial role in ensuring the town centre remained a safe and secure environment for families to enjoy the festivities.

The team's ongoing commitment to tackling business crime led to significant results. Thirteen incidents resulted in deterring or the recovery of stolen goods worth over £998.90 in total. With a proactive intervention that led to the arrest of two prolific offenders responsible for a string of thefts totalling nearly £4,000 from one store alone. Overall, the team's efforts in August led to the recovery of 94% of all reported stolen goods, underscoring our ability to deliver tangible results for businesses.

Looking ahead, we will continue to build on these strong results by focusing on strengthening our collaborations with local businesses and the police. Our strategic focus remains on using our patrol presence and intelligence-gathering capabilities to identify and build cases against repeat offenders, ensuring that we are not just reacting to crime but actively preventing it. The team will also continue to respond to and record breaches of exclusions and court orders, providing the consistent documentation needed for further police action.
